



## NATIONS FOCUS

### DR CONGO

- That the church will practice discipleship and mission in the remote places in the country, and that Christians will increase and practice justice and integrity.
- That the church will pray for and address the political, cultural and economical issues in the country, and with neighboring countries;
- That Christians involved in politics and business will be able to influence their environments as salt and light.
- That elections in December 2018 will come to pass in peace and order, and that DRC will get a wise President full of integrity, and also the Deputies.
- That the power of the Gospel will persuade Muslims and followers of other religions to follow Jesus.
- That the sister school of IGSL in DRC will improve her program and have all the needed resources to equip strategic leaders in DRC and in Africa.

### INDIA

- Pray for endurance for Christians undergoing persecution: India is ranked in the top 25 countries where Christians are facing the most persecution. Hatred against Christians is instigated by anti-Christian extremists. Reports of beatings of pastors and church members are frequent. In some instances, Christians are killed for their faith.
- Pray for missionaries and ministers not to give up despite of all the hardships and challenges they experience.
- Pray for the Good News of Jesus Christ to reach every village and town of India

### INDONESIA

- Indonesia has the biggest Muslim population in the world since 82% of 266,795,000 population are Muslim. Some Muslim radicals are trying to change our constitution from democratic country to Islam country and persecuted the other belief (Protestant, Catholic, Buddhist, Hindu and Confucian). Pray for freedom to practice Christianity in Indonesia.
- Pray for persecuted churches, on 27 September 2018 they closed and sealed 3 churches and planned to close 8 more churches in Jambi city, Indonesia.
- Pray for the government in their effort to eradicate terrorism in Indonesia. In May 2018, a terrorist attacked 2 Police Headquarters and had suicide bombs in 3 churches. They also caused a riot in Indonesia Detention Center.
- Pray for political stability due to the preparation Parliamentary elections on 17 April 2019.

- Pray that God raises up good leaders as we are going to elect president and vice president on 17 April 2019. The candidates to run for election are: Joko Widodo – Ma'ruf Amin and Prabowo Subianto – Sandiaga Uno.



## UNREACHED PEOPLES

There are 2,289 unreached people groups in India (out of 2,554 total people groups) and 235 UPGs (out of 786) in Indonesia. In India the largest religion is Hinduism (81%, over a billion people), but India has the third largest Muslim population in the world, with 177 million people and Indonesia is the home of the most Muslims in the world, with 225 million.

You've been given three UPGs from India and one from Indonesia to pray for this month. You can pray for these people groups using the Scriptures below.

Matthew 11:29 (NIV)



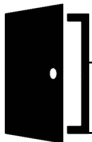
## IGSL DEPARTMENT FOCUS: LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS (LP)
